Immediate Denture Post-Op Instructions

- Leave denture in for 24 hours. DO NOT remove or it may no longer fit.
- After the first 24 hours, you may take out your denture to rinse your mouth. Rinse the gums three times daily with salt water. It will help reduce swelling in the gums. You may rinse your denture gently with cold water.
- Expect soreness in the areas of the extraction and it should decrease over the first week. If the soreness in any one area is increasing please call our office for an adjustment.
- There is a temporary liner inside your denture. It will cushion your gums while they heal. DO NOT use denture cleaners or the liner may come out.
- Construction of your permanent denture will begin in 8 weeks after your surgery.
